Hello,

I believe this is in regard to the AzEDS reporting? To be honest, I don't have access to their system so only have some guidance. I also attached a form I have that ***kind of*** answers this question.

You can only count students who DC, you cannot enter Alternative Income Applications. Essentially, if they don't DC (or have extended eligibility), they will be marked as paid. This is because the alternative income forms are not a USDA form and are only Title 1. **If they don't qualify, they can apply for Sunbucks using the parent application on ADE. This is closed for PY24 though. Next year, you will send your families here.**

MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE JULY 31

Households not identified as eligible by the SFA may complete a [Sun Bucks Household Application](#), which is available now and must be submitted to ADE by July 31, 2024.

Jeannie,

We received your ticket on the Food Service Programs in AzEDS. As of today, we have not yet loaded the Food Service Programs to the LEAs. This will result in errors when trying to submit the data. We are very close to having these entered in for the applicable LEAs. EdKey is one such set of charters that have either an NSLP or SBP. One item of concern is that we are seeing attempts to submit program data at sites which do not have an NSLP or SBP. I am planning an AzEDS Vendor Meeting at the end of August and will update the vendors with the program and expectation.

There is currently a report (FSP10) on the portal that will display this data once it is able to be submitted. My target date to have the programs available was July 15, but there were some issues that kept it from being created before the Statewide Recalculation for Equalization Payments. I am very appreciative that you have begun to collect the Other Source Categorically Eligible data. We will have the programs added in the near future for the LEAs that have NSLP/SBP sites and send a notification to the vendors once that has been completed. I will also ask School Finance to send a Hot Topic on it once the programs become available to help notify any members in the field. It may not be School Finance related, but they have built a very reliable communication path. I will need to find something to offer SF in appreciation. In the meantime, I would ask that we pause on submitting the data until the programs are in production.

You also indicated that you have had success with submitting Homeless Program data. I am very excited for this. We have a new report, the HEP10, which we hope to have in production by the end of next week. We are currently awaiting business approval to move it into production. Both FSP10 and HEP10 will be available as a Support Program data verification report in the AzEDS Portal.

If you would like to post on ASCUS' website that the Food Service Programs have not been added to AzEDS, though they are expected to be added in the near future, that would be lovely. In the meantime, I would ask that we hold off submitting FSP data to AzEDS as the submissions will fail. Once the programs have been added, the only school sites which should have this data submitted are those that are approved by HNS to offer a National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or School Breakfast Program (SBP). Any site that does not have one of these programs should not be sending data to AzEDS. The Income Eligibility I and II needs are also expected for this year. The FRPL ADM that is currently being generated uses the IE needs which are broader in scope than the Food Service Program that relates to a NSLP or SBP.
